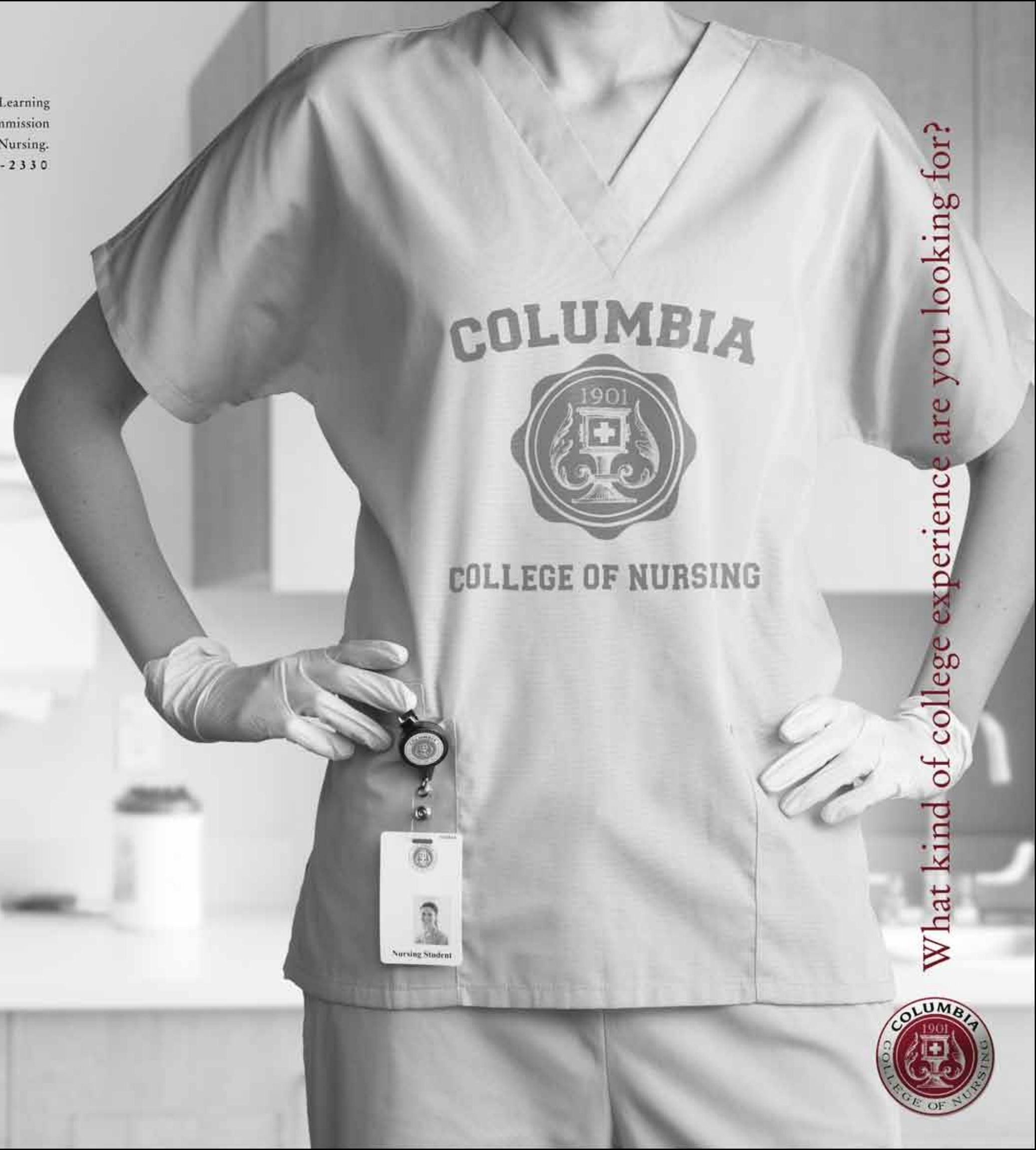




It can be hard to
